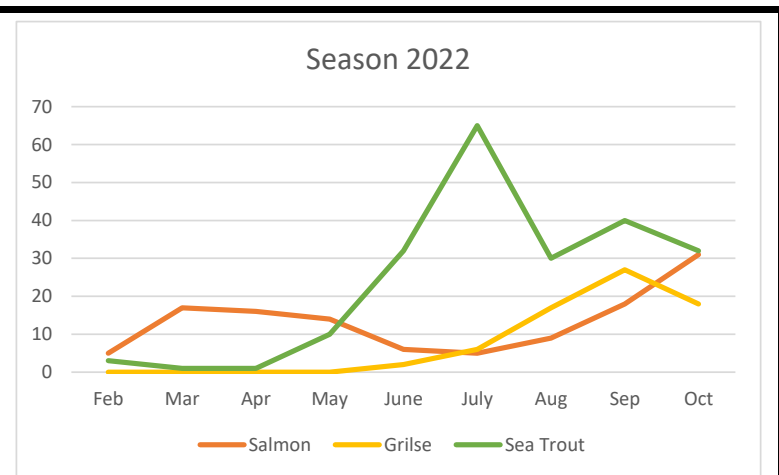


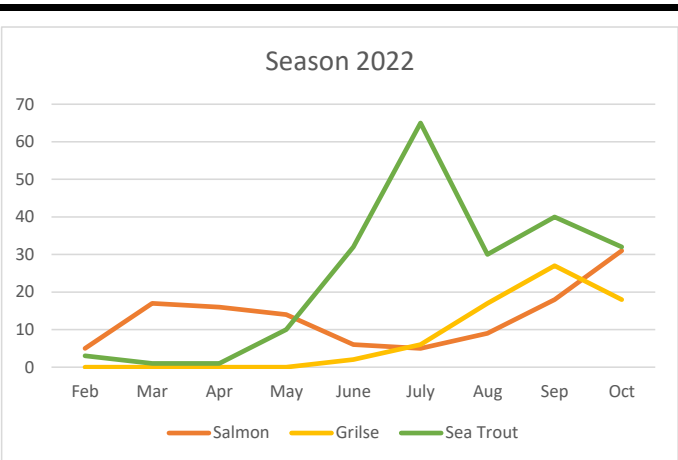

Mr L Sandground had an 8lb fish from Lower Weir and Mr R Galloway also had an 8lb fish from the Luther Pool.</p>
Week 4 21-02-22 to 26-02-22	<p>Caught this week Salmon = 1 Grilse = 0 Sea Trout = 3</p> <p>Fish are still being caught and surprisingly there are a few Sea Trout being taken. Figures for the week are 1 Salmon to 10lbs and 3 Sea Trout to 3-1/2lbs. Mr F Calzetta caught the Salmon on Upper Stobb, Mr J McKinky and Mr R Asquierbo both had 3-1/2lb Sea Trout one from Upper Stobb and one from the Luther Pool and Mr S Salisy had a 2-1/2 lb Sea Trout from the Luther Pool. 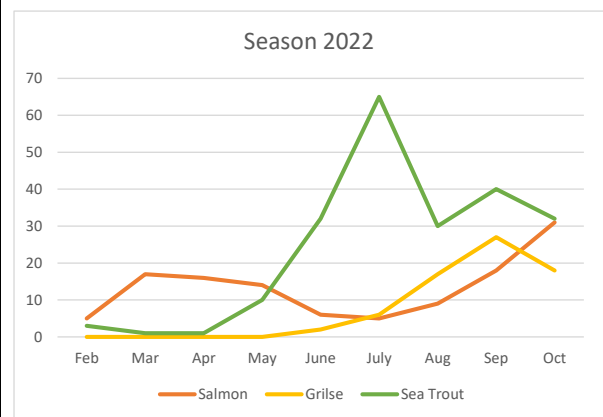


Week 1 28-03-22 to 05-03-22	<p>Caught this week Salmon = 3 Grilse = 0 Sea Trout = 0</p> <p>Fish are still being caught with 3 nice Salmon caught this week, if you are lucky enough to catch one they are in cracking condition. Mr L Sandground had a 10lb Salmon and Mr J Fitzsimmons also had a 10lb Salmon this week using a Willie Gunn one was from the Lower Weir and one from the Boat Pool, Mr P Cowan also had an 8lb fish from the Boat Pool. The river is at a decent and consistant level at present so prospects are still good.</p>
Week 2 07-03-22 to 12-03-22	<p>Caught this week Salmon 4 Grilse 0 Sea Trout 0</p> <p>Couple of days of very high water this week with 4 fish taken for the week. Some big fish showing now Mr C Candlin using a Willie Gunn had 2 fish one from Bridges which was about 9lb and one from Lower Bridges which was 14lbs. To top that Mr M Halszajn had a 15lb fish from the Boat pool using a WillieGunn Snelda. Mr C Cowan had a 7lb fish from Dovecot so 4 fish for the week. River is at a good hight so prospects are good.</p>
Week 3 14-03-22 to 19-03-22	<p>Caught this week Salmon 6 Grilse 0 Sea Trout 1</p> <p>Good week at Pert this week with the water in excellent condition. 6 Salmon and a Sea trout for the week. Mr I MacDonald and Mr G Donaldson took the honours for the biggest fish both had one at 13lbs but Mr MacDonald also had a 12lb and a 10lb fish and a Sea trout for his efforts all taken on a Mac Special. Mr A Hamilton and Mr A Rankin both had fish to 8lbs. Upper Weir, Lower Weir and Upper and Lower Bridges produced the best fish.</p>
Week 4 21-03-22 to 26-03-22	<p>Caught this week Salmon 4 Grilse 0 Sea Trout 0</p> <p>Water levels dropping and bright sunshine making it a difficult week on Pert but there is always someone who can crack the code.</p> <p>Mr J Murray did that with 2 fish in consecutive days one at 9lbs from the Boat pool and one at 12lbs from Bridges. Biggest fish of the week was 14lbs caught by Mr D Hoppe from the Boat pool a 9lb fish was caught on Upper Weir by Mr C Barr. Fish have been seen running the system so the overcast conditions and rain next week will hopefully freshen up the river.</p>



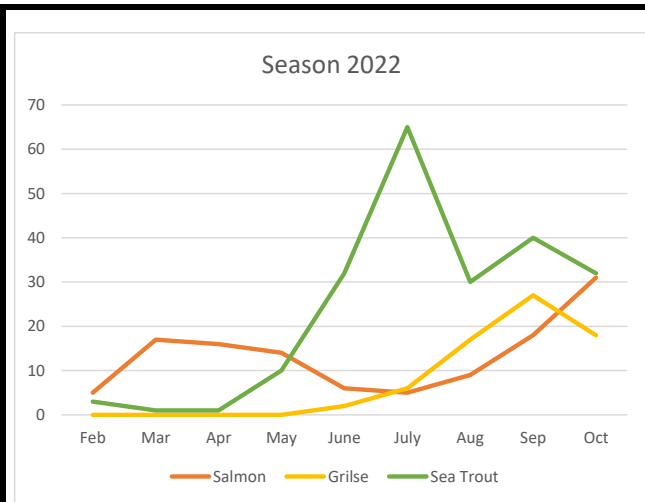


Week 1 28-03-22 to 02-04-22	Caught this week Salmon = 2 Grilse = 0 Sea Trout = 0 Only 2 fish caught this week with Mr A Wilson catching a 9lbr at the Weir pool and Mr I Niven an 8lb fish at Bridges. The good news is there are a lot of fish running the system and with rain forecast for the coming week hopefully conditions will improve.
Week 2 04-04-22 to 09-04-22	Caught this week Salmon = 8 Grilse = 0 Sea Trout = 0 Bit of a disaster this week only 2 fish caught and David and family struck down by covid. To brighten things a wee bit at least the fish caught were 2 crackers Mr S Smith had a 16lb fish from the Luther pool and Mr J Murray had a 12lb fish also from the Luther pool both fish the proverbial bars of silver so the quality is still there. River levels are pretty constant and at decent fishing high so prospects are good. Update to the figures there were actually 8 fish caught for the week, covid got in the way of accurate returns. 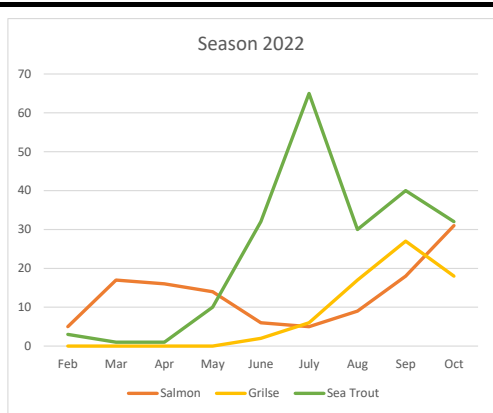

Only one Sea trout caught this week by Mr G Luke, he was using a Black micro tube on the Luther pool.
Week 2 09-05-22 to 14-05-22	Caught this week Salmon = 3 Grilse = 0 Sea Trout = 1 Slight improvement in conditions this week. Mr F Josenci from France had a good week with 2 fish a 9lbs fish from the Weir pool and an 8-1/2lb fish from the Luther pool he also had a 2-1/2lb Seatrout from the Boat pool. Mr R Telfer from Chorley Lancs had a 10-1/2lb fish from the Luther pool. More rain is forecast for the coming week which will hopefully freshen up the water and improve the conditions.
Week 3 16-05-22 to 21-05-22	Caught this week Salmon = 3 Grilse = 0 Sea Trout = 0 Slow going on Pert this week with only 3 fish caught. Mr I King from Edinburgh had a 10lb fish from the Boat pool on a Black and Orange tube. Mr G Wyllie from Kirriemuir had a 9lb fish also from the Boat pool on a Stoats tail and Mr M Dickinson from Wales had a 10lb fish from the Luther pool on the Flying C. Conditions are pretty good at the moment so hopefully fresh fish will soon be entering the system
Week 4 23-05-22 to 30-05-22	Caught this week Salmon = 5 Grilse = 0 Sea Trout = 4 Far better week this week on Pert with 5 Salmon caught and the appearance of a few Seatrout. Biggest fish was a 16lb Salmon taken by Mr D Kelman from Largs on the Lower Weir another big fish was one of 14lbs caught by Mr R Wilson from Balloch Loch Lomond on the Luther Pool he also had a 7lb fish and a 3lb Seatrout from the same pool. Mr G Wyllie from Kirriemuir had an 8lb fish off the Luther pool on a Silver Stoat. Mr C MacFarlane had 2 Seatrout to 2lbs from the Boat pool run off and the Luther pool and Mr J Miller also had a 2lb Seatrout from the Luther pool. 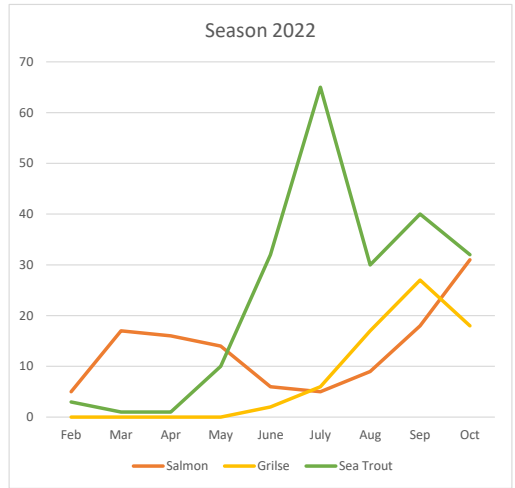

A few Sea trout are showing now with M R R Eseevierbo from Glasgow catch a 5lb specimen on a Needle fly from Upper Weir. Mr D Leiper had a 7lb fish from the Luther pool and a 3lb Sea trout also from the Luther pool both on a Stonchar Stoat Mr J Watson from Glasgow had 2 Sea trout from the Boat pool on the Needle fly 3-1/2lb and 4lb. Mr P Wormald had an 8-1/2lb fish on a Pink Hammer Mr S Salith had an 9lb fish from the Boat pool on a Needle fly and finally Mr S Ingles had a 2lb Sea trout on a Stoats tail from the Boat pool.</p>
<p>Week 2 06-06-22 to 11-06-22</p>	<p>Caught this week Salmon = 2 Grilse = 1 Sea Trout = 3 Bit of an up and down week with conditions very difficult at times, low water and bright sunshine, and a thunderstorm which did nothing for the water levels. I suppose if fishing were easy it would be boring. Mr C Dickinson from Preston had the biggest fish of the week 9lbs taken at the Weir pool on a Red Francis. Mr D Christie had an 8lb fish and a 2-1/2lb Seatrout at the Boat pool, both on a Willie Gunn and Mr J Miller had a 3lb Seatrout from the Luther pool on a Silver Cascade. First Grilse of the season was caught by Mrs M Swanston a 2lbr from the Luther pool. Finally Mr G Donaldson had a 1-1/2lb Seatrout from the Boat pool run off.</p>
<p>Week 3 13-06-22 to 18-06-22</p>	<p>Caught this week Salmon = 3 Grilse = 0 Sea Trout = 2 Getting harder by the week due to lack of water but fish are still being caught Mr J Murray from Ayreshire had a 10lb fish from the Weir pool Mr R Higney caught an 8lb fish from the Luther pool and Mr A Stein had a 7lb fish from the Boat pool so perseverance pays off Mr M Davies and Mr J McEwan both had Seatrout to 2-1/2lbs from the Boat pool and Luther pool. To be honest the fishing is hard what with lack of water and very warm and bright weather, hopefully there will be a change in the coming weeks.</p>
<p>Week 4 20-06-22 to 25-06-22</p>	<p>Caught this week Salmon = 1 Grilse = 1 Sea Trout = 18 Big run of Seatrout this week, of the 20 fish caught for the week 18 were Seatrout. The only Salmon was taken by Mr S Connally a 9lb fish from the Luther pool and a 3lb Seatrout, Mr G Wyllie from Kirriemuir had a 4lb Grilse and 4 Seatrout all from the Luther pool on a Teal Blue and Silver and an Invicta Muddler, Mr C Sandground from Falkirk had 4 Seatrout to 2lbs from the Boat pool on a Micro Tube, Mr C Hood from Lesmahago had 2 Seatrout from the Boat pool on a Silver Butcher, Mr A Kerr also had 2 Seatrout from the Boat pool on a Goats Toe, Mr R McGhee, Mr G Taylor, Mr C Hood, Mr A Tufen, Mr D Leiper and Mr S Ingles all had Seatrout to the 2lb mark. Funnily enough only the Luther pool and Boat pool produced fish this week.</p>
<p>Week 5 27-06-22 to 02-07-22</p>	<p>Caught this week Salmon = 2 Grilse = 0 Sea Trout = 24 The run of Seatrout continues and they are in all the pools on the beat. Mr G Wyllie from Kirriemuir had 6 to 3lbs all on a Teal Blue and Silver. Mr W Auld from Ayreshire had 7 to 3lbs mainly from the Luther pool, Mr C Hood had 2 to 3lbs from the Boat pool on a Red Butcher, Mr S Fullerton from Montrose had 2 to 3lbs on a Purple Shrimp from Blue Stone. there were 2 Salmon caught for the week a 10lb fish for Mr M Leiper at Upper Bridges and an 8lb fish for Mr C Gorman from the Luther pool.</p>



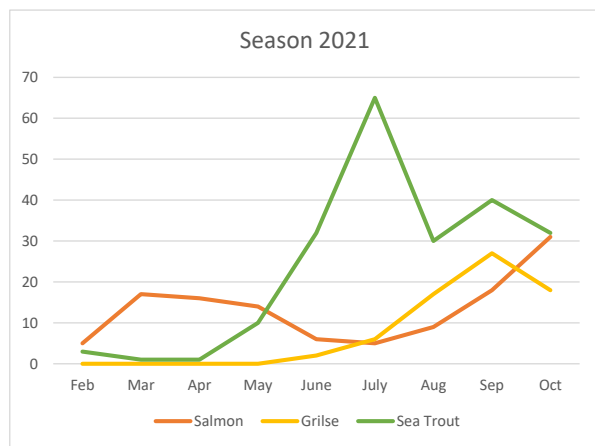


<p>Week 1 04-07-22 to 09-07-22</p>	<p>Caught this week Salmon = 1 Grilse = 0 Sea Trout = 16 Well the Sea trout run is quite prolific and i get the feeling that evening fishing probably in the dark, which is normal for Sea trout fishing, must be the tactic being used by Mr A Atkins from Granton on Spey, over 2 days Mr Atkins caught 16 Sea trout to 3lbs all on a Micro Tube and all from the Boat pool apart from 4 fish they were all returned. Mr C Adams from Derbyshire had a 12lb Salmon, the only one of the week, also from the Boat pool. Hopefully the Grilse will put in an appearance soon but with the water being so low they are probably bidding there time off the coast</p>
<p>Week 2 11-07-22 to 16-07-22</p>	<p>Caught this week Salmon = 1 Grilse = 2 Sea Trout = 10 Despite the low water conditions and bright very hot weather fresh fish are still running and stopping in the pools, especially the Sea trout and now the odd Grilse are beginning to show. On Monday 11th July Mr Matt Davis from Sheffield had a 2lb sea trout from the Upper Weir and a 1.5lb sea trout from the Boat Pool. Mr Jamie Mcallister from Houston Renfrewshire had 2x 2lb sea trout and a 10lb salmon from the Boat Pool on a Blue Micro tube. Mr. Matt Davis had a 5lb grilse from the Luther Pool and a 1.5lb sea trout from Bridges. Mr. David Brown from Alford Aberdeenshire caught a 2lb and 3lb sea trout from the Luther Pool on a Thunder and Lightning, Mr C Hood from Lesmahago had 2 Seatrout to 3lbs and a 6lb Grilse from the Luther pool on a Silver Stoat, Mr M Leiper from Montrose had a 2lb Seatrout from the Boat pool.</p>
<p>Week 3 18-07-22 to 23-07-22</p>	<p>Caught this week Salmon = 0 Grilse = 0 Sea Trout = 4 Low water conditions and bright sunshine were still dominating the weather this week and making the fishing very hard but relief is in sight as last night (24th) there was monsoon conditions in the area which has at least has freshened up the river. The catches for last week were very sparse and not a Salmon or Grilse in sight. Mr C McKerry from Dumbartonshire had a good Sea trout of 3lbs from the Luther pool on a Black/Blue Francis, Mr I Niven had 2 Sea trout to 1-1/2lbs from the Weir pool both on a Black Spider, Mr P Wormald from Bridge of Weir had a 2-1/2lb Sea trout from the Luther pool on a Red/Silver needle fly.</p>
<p>Week 4 25-07-22 to 30-07-22</p>	<p>Caught this week Salmon = 1 Grilse = 4 Sea Trout = 19 Still a lack of water and no sign of any significant rain in the near future. However fish are still trickling in to the system with this week being especially good if you know how to fish for Sea trout. Again the bulk of the catch has been taken by the experts on this fishes habits Mr A Atkins from Grantown on Spey over 2 days had 11 Sea trout all on a Micro tube to 3-1/2lbs he also had a Grilse to 3-1/2lbs on a Hatrick Shrimp all fish were returned. Mr A Crawford from Cumnock had the only Salmon of the week of 12lbs from Upper Bridges, Mr D Leiper had a Sea trout and a Grilse of 4lbs on a Stoats tail, Mr R McGhee, Mr G Wyllie and Mr C Hood all had 2 Sea trout, Mr G Wyllie also had a 4lb Grilse, Mr P Reid had a 4lb Grilse on a Halo Cascade, Mr S Reid had a single Sea trout for his day. Grilse are starting to appear now but there is a desperate need for rain to let the fish up to spawn.</p>



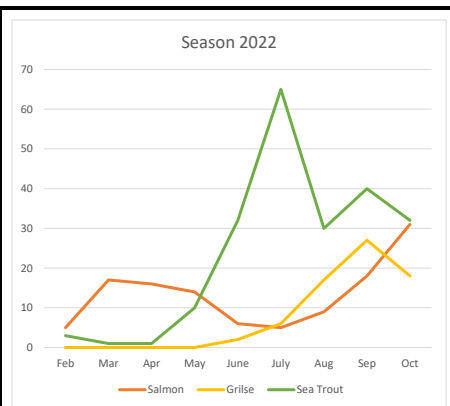


<p>Week 1 01-08-22 to 06-08-22</p>	<p>Caught this week Salmon = 1 Grilse = 5 Sea Trout = 15 Sorry for the lack of updates but ive been on holiday for the past week. I will update this weeks return later because the file ive been sent by David is very blurry and hard to read but here is the gist. Catches are dominated by Sea trout but the Grilse are beginning to appear. Mr P Chisholm had a 5lb Grilse on a Black Frances from Upper Bridges and an 8lb Salmon on a Teal Blue and Silver from Bridges. The next day he had a 4lb Grilse from the Boat Pool. Mr D Baynes had a cracking 4lb Sea Trout on a Bucktail from the Luther Pool.</p>
<p>Week 2 08-08-22 to 13-08-22</p>	<p>Caught this week Salmon = 2 Grilse = 1 Sea Trout = 3 Not such a prolific week as last week with 5 fish caught for the week Mr K Lynch had a couple of Sea trout to 2-1/2lbs on a Stoats Tail from the Boat Pool. Mr M Stewart from Gourrock had a Sea Trout and 2 Salmon of 8lbs and 10lbs from Upper Bridges and Lower Weir. Conditions were very hard due to soaring temperatures but next week we are promised thunder storms so hopefully water levels will rise and freshen up the river.</p>
<p>Week 3 15-08-21 to 20-08-21</p>	<p>Caught this week Salmon = 4 Grilse = 5 Sea Trout = 7 The river is still producing plenty of Sea trout but the Grilse run this year has been very poor so far. Mr I Niven had a good day with a Salmon, 2 Grilse and 2 Sea trout from the Boat pool Mr D Gale from Yorkshire also had a 3lb Grilse from the Boat pool on a Stoats Tail and 3 Sea trout from Blue Stone on a Teal blue and Silver. Mr J Wilson from Glasgow had an 11lb Sea trout on a Stoats Tail from the Boat pool, yes you read that correctly and i have been assured it was a Sea trout, that is an exceptional fish for the North Esk. By the way all the fish caught this week were returned. Mr P Chisholm from Laurencekirk had a 6lb Grilse and an 8lb Salmon from the Boat pool and Mr R Euart from Falkirk had a nice 8lb fish from Bridges on a Stoats Tail. Weather over the next week is supposed to be fairly dry with rain appearing at the weekend.</p>
<p>Week 4 22-08-22 to 27-08-22</p>	<p>Caught this week Salmon = 1 Grilse = 3 Sea Trout = 5 Not a bad week on Pert. Biggest fish was taken by Mr K Brown from Cumbria a 12lb fish from Bridges on a Stoats Tail. A couple of nice Grilse to 5lbs were taken at Luther pool by Mr G McKinly from Huntly using a n Allys Shrimp and Mr A Atkins from Granton on Spey. Mr R McBain from Torphins had 2 nice Sea trout to 3-1/2lbs using Nymphs. Mr A Jackson from Cumbria had a 4lb Grilse and a Sea trout from Lower Weir on a Silver Stoat.</p>



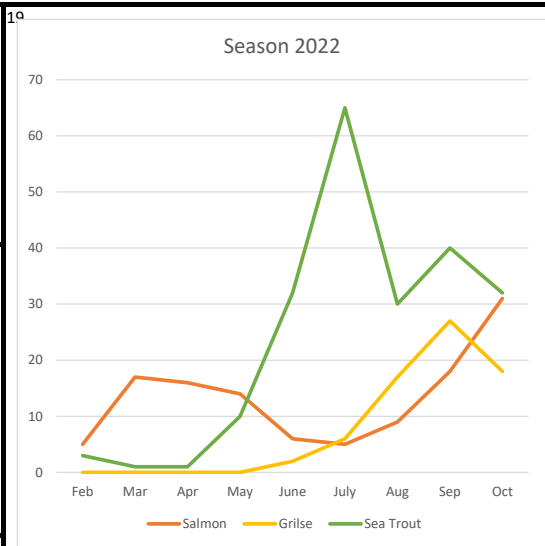


<p>Week 1 29-08-22 to 03-09-22</p>	<p>Caught this week Salmon = 3 Grilse = 4 Sea Trout = 3 Mr M Anderson from Ayrshire had a 7lb fish from Lower Weir, Mr I Niven from Letham had a 5lb Grilse also from Lower Weir on a Micro Cascade. Mr P Goodwin from Derbyshire took a 10lb Salmon at the Luther pool on a Pert Shrimp and he also had a 3lb Grilse on an Ian Bell Special. Mr F Calzeta had an 8lb fish from the Boat pool. Heavy rain is forecast for the coming week and a good spate should clean the river out and hopefully bring in fresh fish.</p>
<p>Week 2 05-09-22 to 10-09-22</p>	<p>Caught this week Salmon = 5 Grilse = 10 Sea Trout = 25 A spate over the weekend and a rise in the water level certainly changed things as the returns details show. Mr S Connally from Stenhouse had a 14lb Salmon at the Boat pool run off, not far behind was Mr N Marshall with a 12lb fish from the Luther pool. Mr R Euart from Falkirk had a good day with 4 Sea trout to 3lbs and 3 Grilse to 6lb all from Blue Stone apart from 1 from the Boat pool. Mr P Wormold had the biggest fish of the week at 18lbs another at 8lbs a grilse of 4-1/2lbs and a Sea trout of 3-1/2lbs all on an Orange Hornet and all from the Boat pool. All the fish caught this week were returned. Prospects look good with the river at a good level and more rain is forecast.</p>
<p>Week 3 12-09-22 to 17-09-22</p>	<p>Caught this week Salmon = 5 Grilse = 8 Sea Trout = 6 Plenty of fish in the water at the moment and all seem willing to take the fly. Obviously a lot of coloured fish with the odd fresh Grilse being taken. Every fish was again returned this week apart from a Grilse of about 4lbs. Undoubted fish of the week was a 12lb Sea trout caught in the Boat pool on a Pert Shrimp by Mr N Lees from Surry, that's the second double figure Sea trout taken from the beat this year. Biggest Salmon was one of 18lbs caught at Bridges by Mr J Wilson of Glasgow on a Sunray Shadow. Mr P Rimmer from Shropshire had a 12lb Salmon from the Boat pool on a Red Francis. Biggest Grilse was 6lbs taken on a Cascade at Bridges by local angler Mr D Leiper.</p>
<p>Week 4 19-09-22 to 24-09-22</p>	<p>Caught this week Salmon = 3 Grilse = 6 Sea Trout = 2 River is back to low level again which is making the fishing very hard. Best fish of the week was a 15lb Salmon caught by Mr M Hood from Bristol, the fish took a Red Francis in the Boat pool. Mr J Murray from Dundonald in Ayrshire had a 12lb fish and a couple of Grilse to 3lbs. Mr R Asquitherbo from Glasgow had a 4lb Grilse and 2 Sea trout to 4lbs all on an Allys Shrimp and all from the Boat pool. Mr G McClarence from Northern Ireland had 2 cracking Grilse of 6lb and 5lb from Lower Weir. With no sign of rain in the near future the fishing will remain challenging.</p>
<p>Week 5 26-09-22 to 01-10-22</p>	<p>Caught this week Salmon = 7 Grilse = 5 Sea Trout = 12 Water levels are pretty consistant at the moment with rain in the hills keeping the river at a decent hight. Still fish being caught and everything this week once again returned to the water. Mr S Connally from Lanarkshire had a good catching 4 Sea trout to 3lbs, 2 Grilse to 6lbs and 2 Salmon to 12lbs, all pools from Bridges to Upper Stobb produced fish. Mr I Grey from Clydebank had the biggest fish of the week a 15lb Salmon from Bridges he also had a 9lb fish from the same pool the Red Francis did the business a 4lb and 5lb Sea trout fell to Mr S Gallacher also from Clydebank both fell to the Pert Shrimp. Mr R Gibson from Huddersfield had a nice 10lb fish from the Luther Pool also on a Red Francis. Mr K O'Hara from Bathgate had a 12lb Salmon, a 6lb Grilse and 2 Sea trout to 3lbs from Upper Stobb and the Luther pool. Mr G Griffon from Lanarkshire had an 11lb fish and 2 Sea trout to 3lbs again the Luther pool and Upper Stobb provided the sport.</p>
