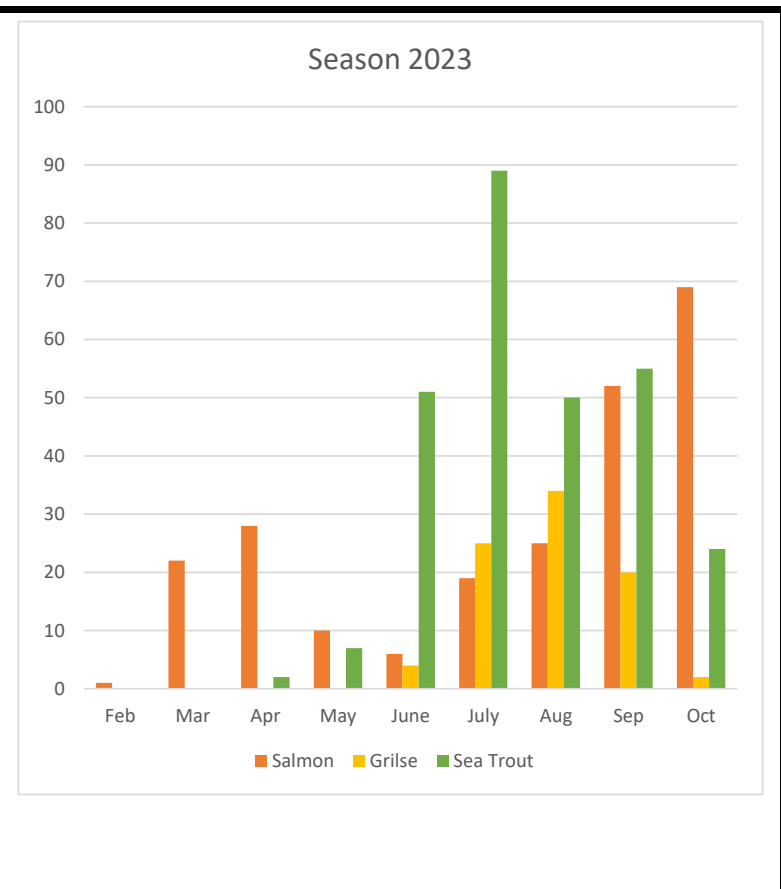


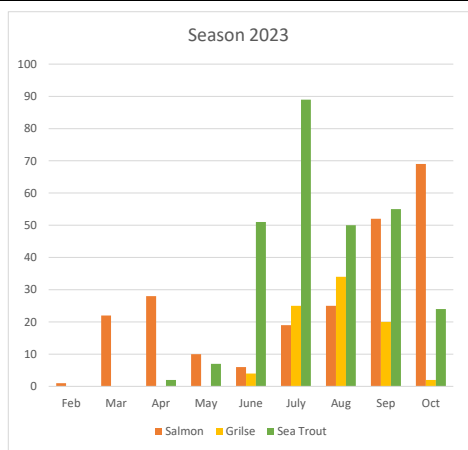

The water is very low at the moment but fish are in the system so there is always a chance.



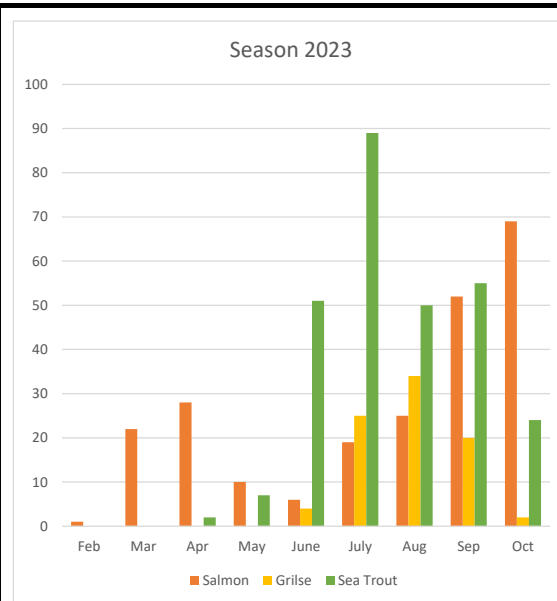

Only one springer caught this week a 6lb fish from the boat pool caught on a Bann Special by Mr G Wyllie from Kirriemuir.

Week 3 13-03-23 to 18-03-23	Caught this week Salmon 10 Grilse 0 Sea Trout 0 Amazing what a bit of water can do finally the fish have decided to run the river rain and snow melt obviously encouraged the fish into the system. 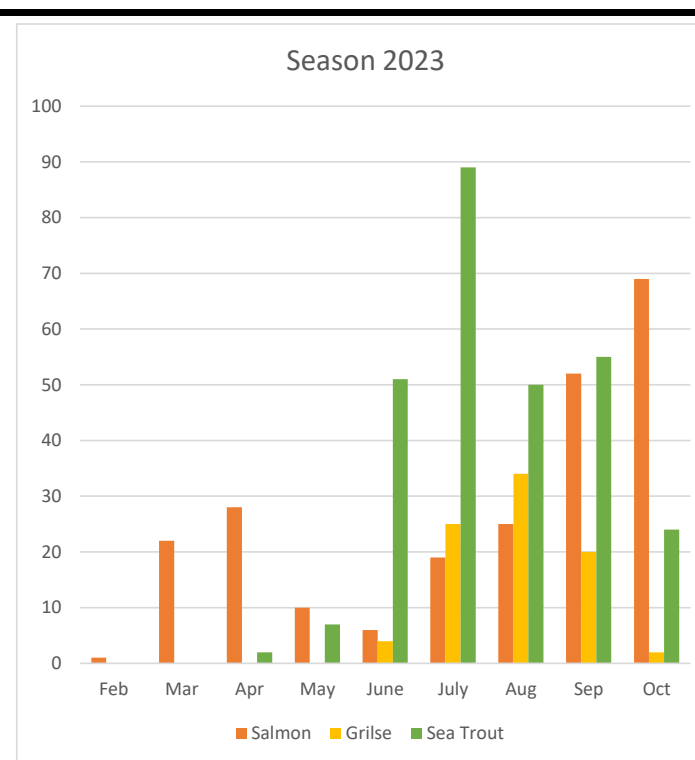

Mr I Manoen from Glasgow had a 10lb fish from Bridges. Mr. A Preston from Dunblane had an 8lb fish from Lower Weir and Mr. J Mitchell from Doune took a 10 pound fish from the Boat pool. Finally Mr R Brown from Falkirk caught a 6lb fish on Upper Bridges. With water conditions pretty good and more rain forecast for this next week hopefully more fish will enter the system.</p>

A lot of heavy rain fell this week so prospects for next week look to be a excellent with the water at perfect hight.</p>

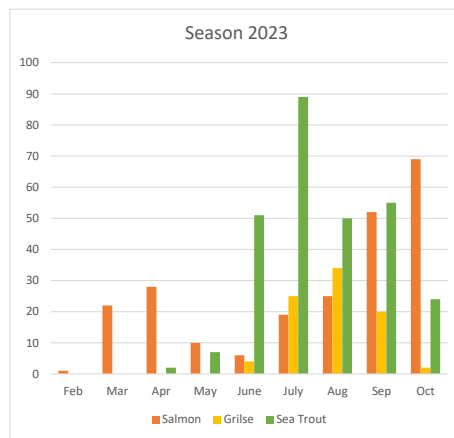

Week 2 08-05-23 to 13-05-23	Caught this week Salmon = 2 Grilse = 0 Sea Trout = 2 Sea trout starting to make an appearance 2 both about 2-1/2lbs 1 taken by Master F Rankin from Hamilton and 1 by Mr R Telfer from Cumbria. Mr G McKinlay from Montrose had an 18lb Salmon from the Boat pool and Mr C Chamberlane from Darwin Lancs had a 6-1/2lb fish from the Luther pool.
Week 3 15-05-23 to 20-05-23	Caught this week Salmon = 4 Grilse = 0 Sea Trout = 1 Another Sea trout caught this week, 2-1/2lbs caught by Mr G McKinlay on a Stoats Tail. Mr J Murray from Dundonald had a 15lb fish from Lower Weir and a 7lb fish from the Boat pool. Mr S Guild from Ayrshire had an 11lb fish from the Boat pool and a 9lb fish from Upper Weir.
Week 4 22-05-23 to 27-05-23	Caught this week Salmon = 3 Grilse = 0 Sea Trout = 3 Very low water and bright conditions is making the fishing very hard only 4 Salmon and 2 Sea trout caught this week. Mr F Calzena from Stirling had an 8lb fish from the Boat pool, this proved to be the biggest fish of the week a 6lb fish was taken by Mr S Mason also from Stirling and also from the Boat pool . A couple of very small fish were recorded in the 2lb to 2-1/2lb mark. also a couple of Sea trout in the 2-1/2lb range were caught one by Mr C McDonald using a Muddler and one by Mr S McAuly using a Micro tube. The forecast for the next week is to be very warm with bright sunshine so i would say late evening would give the best chance of a fish.



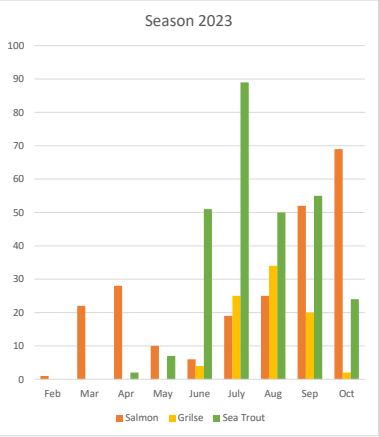


Week 1 29-05-23 to 03-06-23	Caught this week Salmon = 0 Grilse = 0 Sea Trout = 1 Fishing is pretty poor at the moment, river is very low and bright conditions throughout the day are making it very difficult to tempt the fish. Only 1 Sea trout caught this week by Mr P Irvine from Edinburgh taken at the Luther pool and weighing in at approx 3lbs. Unless there is significant rain in the coming days its hard to see any improvement.
Week 2 05-06-23 to 10-06-23	Caught this week Salmon = 4 Grilse = 0 Sea Trout = 6 Mr G McKinley from Montrose had 2 Salmon from the Luther Pool one at 9lbs and one at 11lbs, Mr. J Wilson from Glasgow had 2 Sea trout also from the Luther pool both on a Silver Stroat one at 5lbs and one at 3lbs, the next day Mr. J Wilson again had 2 Sea trout one at 4lbs and one at 5lbs both on the Silver Stroat, Mr G Deans from Glasgow also had a Sea trout of 2lbs and a small Salmon of about 3lbs one on the Silver Stroat and one on a Silver Toby, Mr C Sandground from Monikie had a 2lb sea trout on a Micro tube from the Luther pool, Mr. J McGlynn from Falkirk had a 7lb fish from Lower Weir. Thundery showers are expected in the coming week which may help the water level.
Week 3 12-06-23 to 17-06-23	Caught this week Salmon = 0 Grilse = 2 Sea Trout = 8 Better week this week even though bright conditions and low water is still the norm. The first of the Grilse have started to appear with Mr S Conroy from Cardross and Mr J McPhail from Connecticut USA catching to 7lb and 5lb respectively. Mr M Davis from Sheffield had a 4lb Sea trout from Bridges and Master F Rankin had a 3-1/2lb Sea trout from the Luther pool. Mr A Atkins had 3 Sea trout to 3-1/2lbs and Mr C Sandground had 3 Sea trout to 2-1/2lbs also on a Micro tube. Rain is forecast which will freshen up the river over the next week.
Week 4 19-06-23 to 24-06-23	Caught this week Salmon = 2 Grilse = 2 Sea Trout = 19 Conditions have improved and there has been a big influx of Sea trout with some crackers amongst them, notably a couple of 4lb fish and a 6lbr with most of them in the 2-1-2lb to 3lb range. The Grilse are slow to appear though with only two caught for the week. Mr D Scott had a 5lb Grilse and a Sea trout to 2lbs. Mr G Donaldson had a Grilse to 2lbs and a Sea trout of the same size. Mr R Tomkins had a 10lb Salmon. Mr C McDonald had an 8lb Salmon and 2 Sea trout to 2-1/2lbs. Mr C Sandground had a great couple of days taking 8 Sea trout the biggest tipping the scales at 6lbs all on a Micro tube. Mr S Connally had 3 Sea trout to 3lbs. The Boat pool and Luther pool were by far the most prolific with Upper weir producing one fish.
Week 5 26-06-23 to 01-07-23	Caught this week Salmon = Grilse = 0 Sea Trout = 18 No Salmon or Grilse caught this week but the Sea trout are prolific at the moment 18 caught ranging from 1-1/2lbs to 6lbs. Mr C McDonald from Banchory had 2 to 2-1/2lbs. Mr C Sandground had 3 to 5lbs Mr L Sandground had a cracker at 6lbs, biggest of the week. Mr P McGlynn from Falkirk had 3 to 4lbs. Mr A Atkins from Granton on Spey had 5 to 4lbs. Mr D Murray from Dunnoon had 3 all in the 2-1/2lb range, all the above fish were caught on Micro Tubes. Finally Mr W Auld from Kilmarnock had 1 at 2 1/2 lbs on a Stinchar Stroat. The Boat pool was far and away the most prolific with 12 fish caught the remaining 6 were caught on the Luther pool.



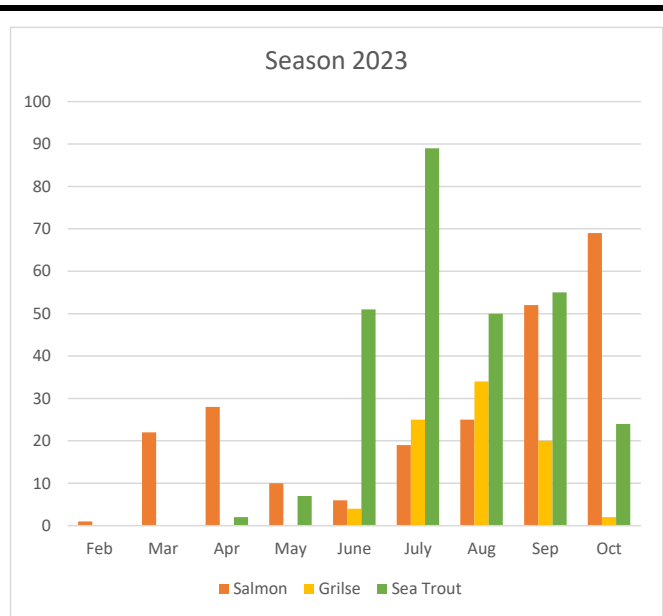


Week 1 03-07-23 to 08-07-23	<p>Caught this week Salmon = 0 Grilse = 0 Sea Trout = 8</p> <p>And still the Sea trout keep coming but a distinct lack of Salmon or Grilse, the low water conditions are definitely having an adverse effect on the fishing. 8 Sea trout for the week Mr A Atkins from Granton on Spey had 6 to 3lbs over 2 days all on a Micro tube Mr S Guthrie from Glasgow took a 4lb Sea trout on a Micro tube and Mr S Hayhurst bucked the trend by taking a 2lb Sea trout on a Teal Blue and Silver every fish was caught on the Boat pool and they were all returned.</p>
Week 2 10-07-23 to 15-07-23	<p>Caught this week Salmon = 11 Grilse = 10 Sea Trout = 39</p> <p>Well what a difference a bit of water makes to the fishing. River was in spate at end of week and the fish made the most of it, the figures speak for themselves. Notable catches were Mr G McCaully from Montrose had 4 Salmon to 12lbs a 6lb Grilse and a 3 1/2lb Sea trout all from the Boat pool. Mr M Davies from Sheffield had 7 Sea trout to 4lb and a 4lb Grilse from the Luther pool, Mr B Milne from Glasgow had a 7lb Sea trout from the Boat pool. Mr J McIver from Ayrshire caught 2 Grilse to 4lb and a 10lb Salmon all from Bridges. Mr R McGhee from Forfar had a Grilse of 3-1/2lb and 2 Sea trout to 4lbs on a Teal Blue and Silver, Mr J Watson from Glasgow had a 10lb Salmon and 3 Sea trout on the Medicine Fly from the Boat pool and Weir pool. 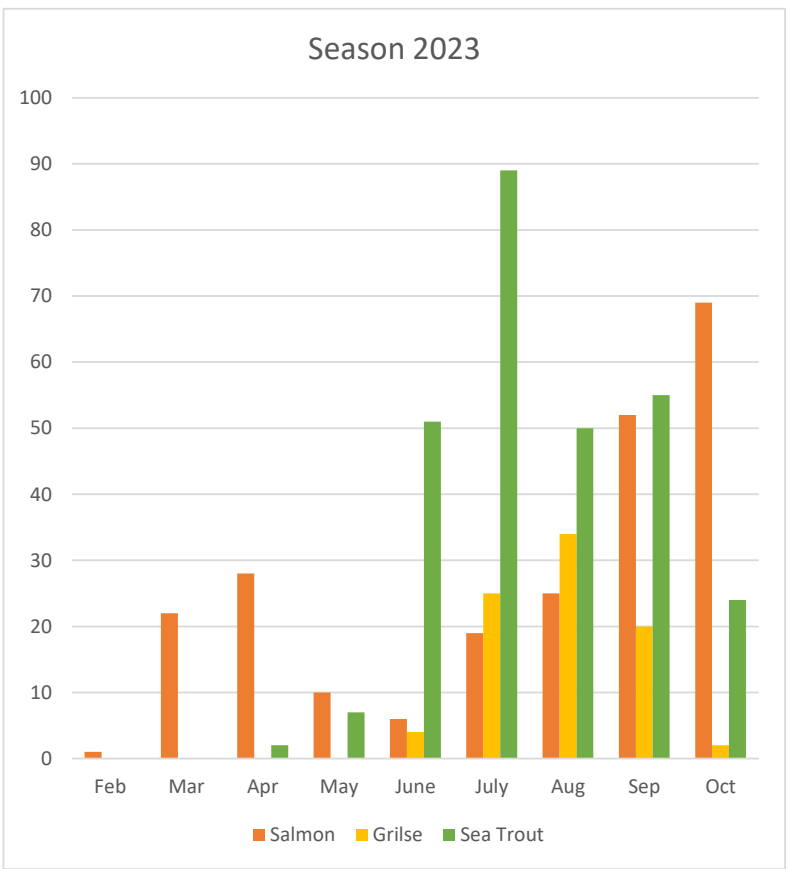
Caught this week Salmon = 8 Grilse = 14 Sea Trout = 7

28-08-23 to 02-09-23

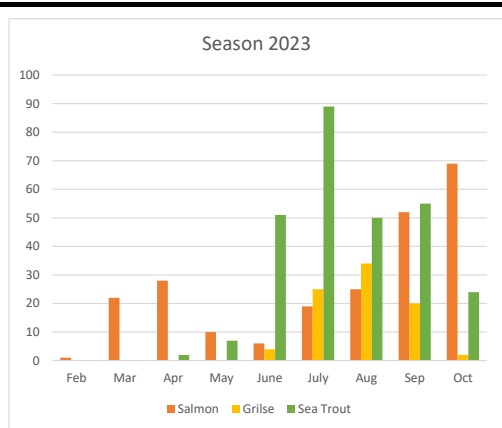
Caught this week Salmon = 1 Grilse = 3 Sea Trout = 7

This is by far the most prolific week of the season, there were so many fish caught that I cant possibly mention all the lucky anglers so I will pick out a few highlights. Firstly the biggest fish fell to Mr G McClarence from Northern Ireland a 22lb fish from the Luther pool he also had a 14lb fish from the Boat pool run off and a 16lb from the Weir pool and another 16lb fish from Lower Weir an 8lb fish and a 5lb Grilse from the Boat pool. Mr J Watson from Ayrshire had a terrific basket for the week 3 Salmon to 10lbs, 4 Grilse to 6lbs and 4 Sea trout to 3lbs the Junction Shrimp being his best fly. Mr J Murray had a 15lb fish from Upper Weir. There were plenty of fish in the 7lb to 10lb as well as the best run of Grilse this season Sea trout are tapering off now but prospects for decent catches are good with water hight to be pretty consistent though heavy rain is forecast for mid week.</p>

Mr P Dickinson from Huddersfield also had a 15lb fish from Lower Weir. Mr R Gibson from Wales caught another 15lb fish from the Boat pool on a Red Francis. Biggest fish of the week though was an 18lb from the Boat pool caught by Mr P Raybound from Warwickshire. Mr C Hood from Lesmahagow had a good basket of 6 Sea trout to 3lbs from Upper Stobb and Mr D Grant from Lanarkshire also had a good catch of 5 Sea trout to 3lbs also from Upper Stobb. Conditions continue to look good for the week ahead.</p>





Week 1
02-10-23 to 07-10-23

Caught this week Salmon = 16 Grilse = 0 Sea Trout = 3
Not such a prolific week this week, 16 Salmon caught along with 3 Sea trout. Biggest fish of the week was caught by Mrs M Dickinson from Wales, 18lbs from the Luther pool. Mr Tom Marshal had a nice 9lb fish on a Silver Stroat from the Boat pool. Mr C Gorman took a 14lb fish at the Boat pool and Mr J Stringer from Glasgow had a 13lb fish also from the Boat pool. Mr P Wormold from Bridge of Weir had 3 fish two at 8lbs and one at 6lbs from the Mill pool and Black burn pool. Mr G McKinlay from Montrose also had 3 fish two at 6lbs and one at 8lbs from Bridges and Luther pool. Mr D Cairns from Aberdeen had 2 fish one at 4lbs from Lower Weir and one at 10lbs from the Boat pool. Mr A Rankin from Hamilton had 2 Sea trout to 2-1/2lbs from Dovecot. There was a huge spate over the weekend of 7th and 8th so a run of fish is sure to happen after the river fines down a bit.

Week 2
09-10-23 to 14-10-23

Caught this week Salmon = 21 Grilse = 2 Sea Trout = 17
A good week on Pert with some big fish caught unfortunately the Grilse run hasn't materialised but the Sea trout run has been exceptional. Biggest fish of the week fell to the rod of Mr A Gale from Derbyshire, a 25lb fish from Upper Stobb. Not far behind was Mr A Westley from Cambridge with a 23-1/4lb fish from Upper Bridges on a Goldeneye Fly and Mr T Westley had a 17lb fish on a Cascade from Black Burn. Mr D Christie of East Kilbride took a 15lb fish also from Upper Bridges. Mr G Luke from East Kilbride had a couple of nice fish of 8lbs and 4lbs from the Mill pool on a Pink Francis. There were a lot of fish in the 5 lb to 10lb range. The first few days of next week should be good but stormy conditions are forecast from Thursday and into the weekend with weather warnongs in place.

Week 3
16-10-23 to 21-10-23

Caught this week Salmon = 13 Grilse = 0 Sea Trout = 1
Devastating storm cut this weeks fishing short but there was some good fish caught at the beginning of the week Mr T McLeary from Perthshire had the biggest fish at 26lbs from Blue Stone he also had another 2 fish at 5lbs and 4lbs. Mr C McKerry from Dumbartonshire had 3 fish on the Red Francis the biggest being 15lbs from Dovecote and Bridges. Mr M Meikle from Doune took a 20lb fish from the Boat pool and a 9lb fish from Lower Weir. The river reached its highest ever level during storm Babet with major damage on all beats so the fishing is going to be unpredictable for the rest of the season.

Week 4
23-10-23 to 31-10-23

Caught this week Salmon = 19 Grilse = 0 Sea Trout = 3
Well storm Babet managed to raise the river level just a tad but there was still some fishing effort once the level dropped. Mr G McKinlay from Montrose had 4 fish to 11lbs and a Sea trout and Mr T McLeary from Perthshire took 3 fish to 7lbs all were taken from the Boat pool. Mr L Sandground took 6 fish biggest of which was 11lbs taken on a Red Francis all from Boat pool or Boat pool run off. Mr J Hainierman had the biggest fish of the week at 15lbs from Blue Stone while Mr R Euart had a 9lb Salmon from the Luther pool and Mr C Sandground had a 4lb Samon from the Boat pool run off. Only 2 days of the season left but the river is still fishable at the moment. On the last 2 days of the season there were another 4 Salmon and 2 Sea trout caught. Biggest fish was 15lbs caught by Mr P Chisholm from Laurencekirk Mr T McLeary from Perthshire had an 8lb fish from the Luther pool
